If you are regularly late ask yourself WHY? Do you need to set your alarm earlier? Do you need to get dressed quicker?



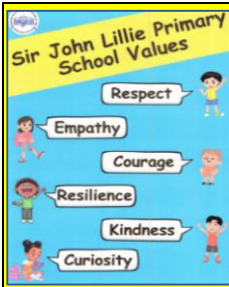
If you need help to get to school on time, come and chat to us.

Get Set 4 Education

What you need: 1 x pair rolled up socks, 2 x cushions, 2 x players

Practise:

- Practise throwing the socks to a partner.
- Every 4 successful catches move back a little bit and try again.

How to play:

- Place the cushions 4m apart.
- How many times can you run between the cushions without being hit by the socks.
- Thrower can only aim below the shoulders.
- Swap roles.

What you need: Household items, a ball or rolled up socks

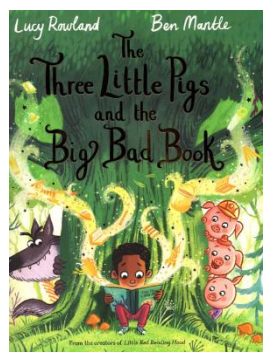
