We would also like to **thank you all** for playing such an important role in our inspection and also making SJL the amazing community it is 😊



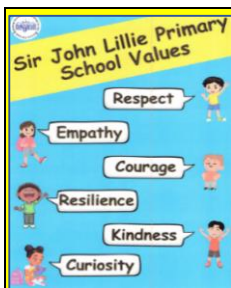
A fabulous world book day full of amazing characters and super sleepy pyjamas 😊

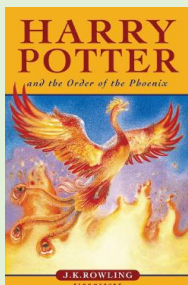
