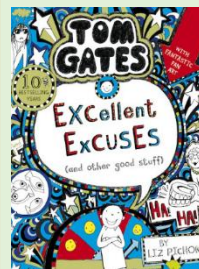


A sprinkle of Sorcery

- Share how good attendance routines help them in life.

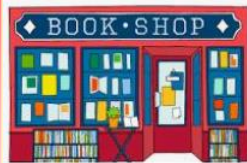
Brain nibbles....

Puzzle time

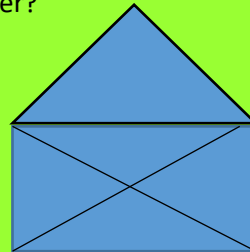
A mixture of puzzles this week ☺

Can you draw this shape WITHOUT taking your pencil off the paper?



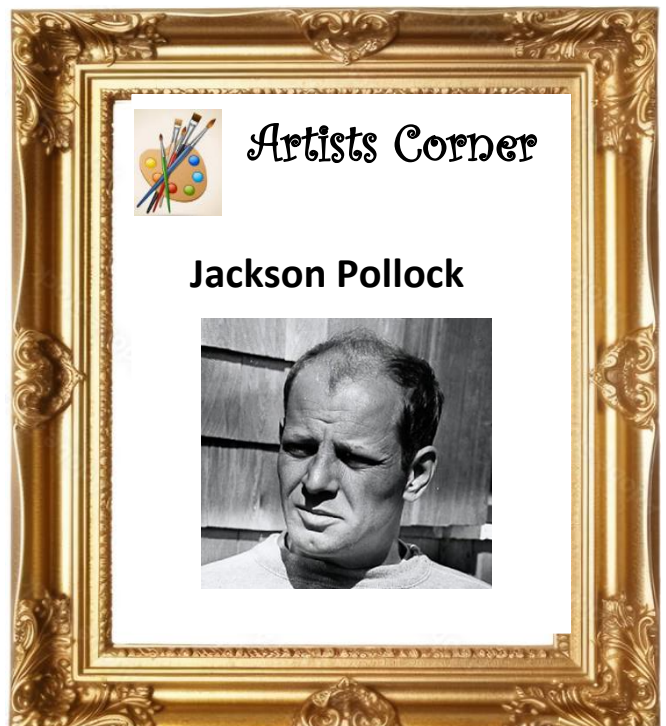

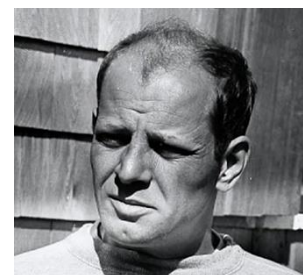

What you need: a quiet space

Breathing techniques help our bodies to relax, slow our heart rate and feel calmer.

How to play:

- Keep your lips lightly sealed.
- Breathe in through your nose and then breathe out making a 'mmmm' sound until you need to breathe in again.
- The longer your 'bee hum', the more relaxed you are likely to be.
