Sadly, we are unable to monitor your child on their devices at home.

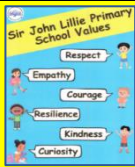
Please check the 'parental controls' you have in place on all devices.

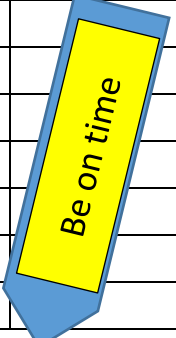

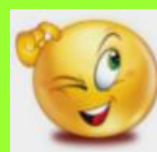
