They took part in workshops that help with life skills.



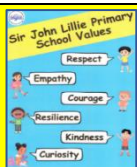
Year 5 trip to Kings cross

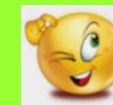

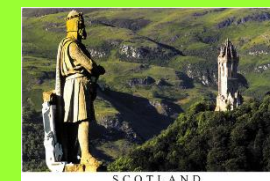


Puzzle time

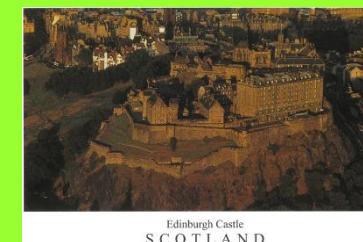
