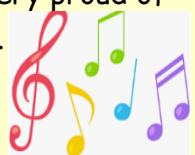

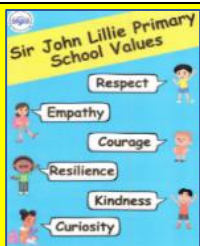

Writing is a teacher assessment score.

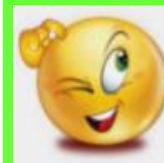


We are above the national average in all four subjects.
