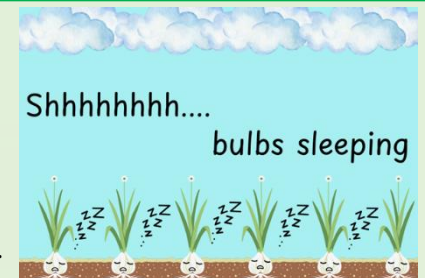

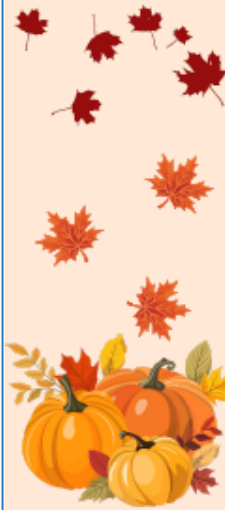

I hope all my dreams come true.

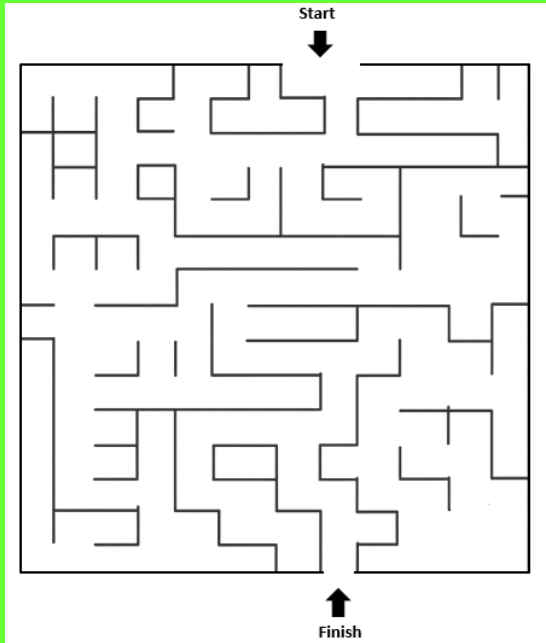
Year 4 have been writing poems to enter into the Young Writers' "I have a dream" competition.
