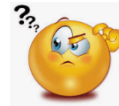

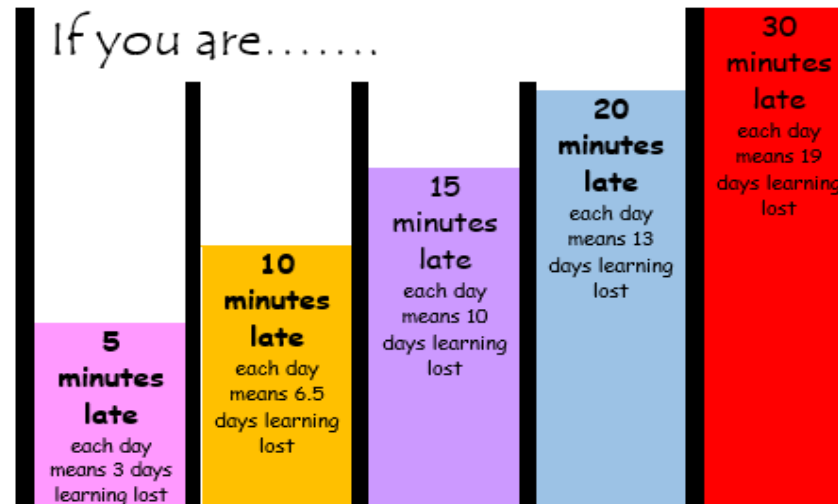
Thank you to all of you who attended the parents evening and respected the new timers for 10 minute appointments.
