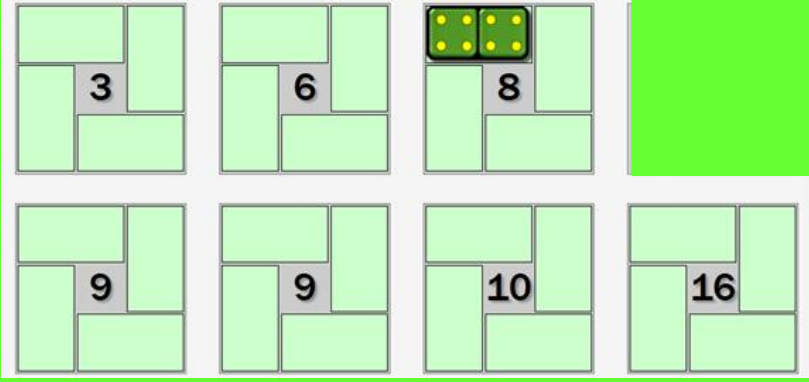

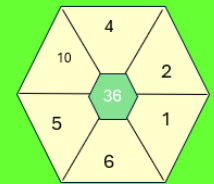
# Dominoes Puzzle



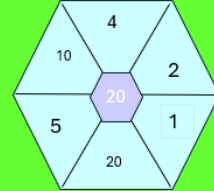
Rotate
