SAT results 2026

We are so very proud to share our SAT results from summer 2026.

There were 32 children in our Year 6 last year. The children took tests in three subjects: Maths, Reading, and Spelling Punctuation and Grammar. They were also assessed in writing across the school year.

We achieved a combined score of 84% in Reading, Writing and Maths.

This is an excellent achievement by the children, families and staff.
