Family Learning Recycled Jewellery:

On Wednesday's late afternoon, from 12th May to Wednesday 16th June 5-week course. 4pm – 6pm, excluding half term.

During these sessions' families will design and make various colorful pieces of recycled jewellery. They will be using some tools (scissors & ruler) together with their child/ children and explore a variety of materials safely and correctly. Literacy, numeracy and ICT will be included in the lessons.

By the end of these courses' families should learn how to make simple unique items of jewellery using a variety of methods, together with learning about the use of color, line and texture in jewellery making and explore different methods of making jewellery by using recycled materials. It's fun, creative and totally unique to you and your child! **It is aimed for children aged 6 plus.**

Family Learning Yoga:

This is a drop in session but to secure a place on a session you will need to confirm with the tutor dates the you will be attending. The course will support and enable Parent / carers to understand and develop strategies to support their child with managing maths homework.

It will also look at the right learning environment, how to manage difficulties, explore techniques and strategies to overcome topic barriers, as well as advice to manage ongoing and persistent problems.

This is a 10 week course that must be attended with a Parent/ Carer and child.

Homework Club 2 is on **Friday afternoon** from 16.00 -18.00pm. It starts on **Friday 14th May 2021** and ends on **11th June 2021**. A four week support group to help parent and child with their English homework. This is aimed from Year 5 ,6 and Year 7.

1- Foil Craft, 2- Recycled Jewellery & Waving Paper.

This will be an opportunity to try a number of different Arts / Crafts mediums, over a number of weeks, such as Foil Craft, Drawing and Recycled Jewellery and weaving paper.

We will be aiming to widen the types of crafts offered on each new course. **These sessions are aimed at 6 Plus.**

1 - Family Foil Craft:



Be Inspired by colourful wooden animals from Mexico, Families will learn how to create fun sculptures of animals using kitchen foil and masking tape. You can work together with your child/children modelling the foil using hands, fingers and everyday items such as spoons and making the body and legs in stages. You will be inspired by online pictures and step by step guidance from your tutor. It's fun, colourful, interesting and very rewarding! **This class is for ages 6 years and up.**

2 - Family Recycled Jewellery:



A fun, exciting taster session to introduce families to design & making various colorful pieces of recycled jewellery. They will be using some tools (scissors & ruler). The jewellery will be individualized to you, encouraging recycling and exploring different methods of making jewellery. It's fun, creative and totally unique to you and your child! **This class is for ages 6 years and up.**

3 - Weaving Paper:



During this fun and easy to do course, you will create simple, colorful, paper weavings. You will design your own patterned papers and then cut these into strips, alongside magazines and newspapers too, to create your own beautiful weaving.

Using simple materials: such as printer paper and felt tip pens, you and your child will explore a range of hand-made weaving designs.

Literacy, numeracy and ICT will be included in the session.

For example; counting the number of woven strips, researching images for the workshop on the Internet, measuring the strips of paper and talking about the environment, recycling paper and saving trees. **This class is for ages 6 years and up.**
