

Learning through lockdown

Sir John Lillie Primary is committed to ensuring that all children have access to learning through lockdown.

As a school we will:

- contact all parents weekly by phone/email or through Google Classroom
- upload online activities each day onto Google Classroom
- give feedback to children on the work they upload
- give support on Google Classroom to our families over the phone
- support children with EHCP and other identified pupils with SEN with a paper pack of resources and interventions weekly
- deliver live lessons weekly and record for children unable to access at set time
- upload recorded lessons.

Google Classroom is the online platform we will use.

Children will:

- have login details, username and password
- have been taught how to access the platform in school
- be expected to log on daily to complete activities
- be expected to log in to live lessons or watch recorded lesson and complete tasks
- be expected to upload work they have completed for teacher feedback.

Parents and carers

Parents and carers will work in partnership with the school to enable their child to successfully learn through lockdown and:

- support their child with learning through lockdown
- ensure children are accessing home learning daily
- go to the **school website - Children – Google Classroom** and to learn how to use google classroom
- create a structured daily learning routine for your child (please see school website for an example)
- provide an area for your child to work in
- reply to all communications from school
- contact the class teacher if you have any questions or concerns.
