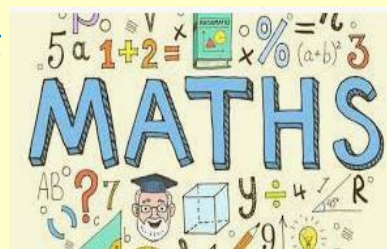

We all use the maths skills we were taught at school every day.







We use it to help us in many ways: when we are buying food or measuring for new clothes; managing our bank accounts; preparing and cooking; working out when we were born; reading what the time is and measuring for new furniture or looking at shapes of furniture to fit in to our rooms.

We are ALL mathematicians.

How can you help your child to become a confident mathematician?

On your way home, at home or when you are out and about

- add the numbers on car number plates 
- count money together 
- read the numbers on the buses, add them together
- see how many circles or triangles you can see in your home
- chant the times tables when you are on a family walk
- read a recipe together and use the scales to measure the ingredients 
- set a fun challenge for ten minutes using a clock.
