How has your week been? We've been so busy ☺



She came in and talked about her job and told us about the Air Ambulance helicopters that are called to very serious incidents across London. In each helicopter there are two doctors, one paramedic and two pilots. Firefighters stand on the helipad to make sure that it lands safely.

The smallest space they are able to land on is the size of a tennis court.

In 2021 the London Air Ambulance Team saved 1117 people's lives. Isn't that fantastic ☺


Is your child always late to school?
