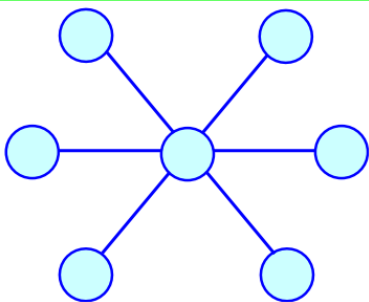

## Our Firework Code

**NEVER** play with or throw fireworks  
They are explosive and can hurt you

**ONLY** adults should light or hold fireworks

**WHEN** you are watching fireworks, stand well back

**NEVER** go near a firework that has been lit.  
Even if it hasn't gone off, it could still explode

If you have a pet, make sure it is safely indoors as fireworks might frighten it or make them run off

### If you are given a sparkler

**ALWAYS** wear gloves

**HOLD** the sparkler away from your body and don't wave it around. You could burn yourself or somebody else

**WHEN** your sparkler goes out, don't touch it. It could still burn you

**NEVER** give sparklers to a child under five
