





Sunday 5th November is firework night. If you attend a fireworks party this weekend, please make sure you know the firework code and stay well away from the fireworks.

NEVER play with or throw fireworks. They are explosive and can hurt you

ONLY adults should light or hold fireworks

WHEN you are watching fireworks, stand well back

NEVER go near a firework that has been lit. Even if it hasn't gone off, it could still explode

If you have a pet, make sure it is safely indoors as fireworks might frighten it or make them run off

If you are given a sparkler

ALWAYS wear gloves

HOLD the sparkler away from your body and don't wave it around. You could burn yourself or somebody else

WHEN your sparker goes out, don't touch it. It could still burn you

NEVER give sparklers to a child under five
