**School Screener Portal**

The CLCH School Nursing Team are using a new electronic way of communicating with parents and carers through a secure web-based portal.

**Process:**

**STEP 1:** Please either register for an account if this is your first time using the Thomson parent portal, or login if you have already created an account. If this is your first time registering, you will receive an email to confirm your account and set a password.

**STEP 2:** Once you login, you can read the information and complete the form.

**Please be aware your browser needs to be an up to date one, such as Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, etc. Internet Explore does not support the application.**

All health-related information is kept confidential. However, in some instances information may be shared on a need-to-know basis with other services in order to be able to better support your child in school. The School Nurse will contact you to discuss the need to share health-related information where relevant.

**Year 6 Parents:**

Parents of year 6 children will need to sign up if they wish to receive results from their child's NCMP measurements.

It's a quick process and all that parents and carers will need is an email address. The parent Portal is GDPR compliant, so personal data is safe.

**What is NCMP?**

Every year in England, school children in Reception and year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP).

We collect this information because it helps to see the changes in statistics and for School Nurses to deliver help and guidance for those who may need additional support. Your child's class will take part in this year's programme.

The checks are carried out within the school day by registered school nurses and/or trained health care professionals. Children are measured fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes.

The weight and height results are shared with you on the **PARENT PORTAL** and will not be shared with the school. It is your choice if you share the information with your child or school. If you are concerned about your child's growth, weight, body image or eating patterns, please seek further support from your School Nurse or General Practitioner.

If there are any concerns regarding your child's growth, a letter will be posted at a later date.

**Please note**: you will NOT receive a letter if your child is a healthy weight.
