Year 5 have been using the science room this week to carry out an experiment measuring forces. We tested how the shape of an object alters its water resistance. To measure this, we had to calculate the time an object took to drop in water. We used the method of counting in thousands to estimate the time in seconds and then averaged our findings.



Huge thank you to all the parents who joined us on Wednesday morning for fun science activities. We planted lots of different seeds, e.g. sunflowers, lettuce and beans. We went on a spring walk around the playground to see what signs of spring we could spot out there. We also made some spring rain by dripping colourful solutions through a cloud of shaving foam.

Well done to all the children who completed the SJL book travel challenge.

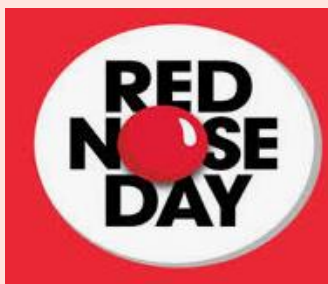
Congratulations to the winners: Kalro (Y1), Bilaney (Y6), Oscar (Y3), Sydney (Y5) and Freddie (Y6).
