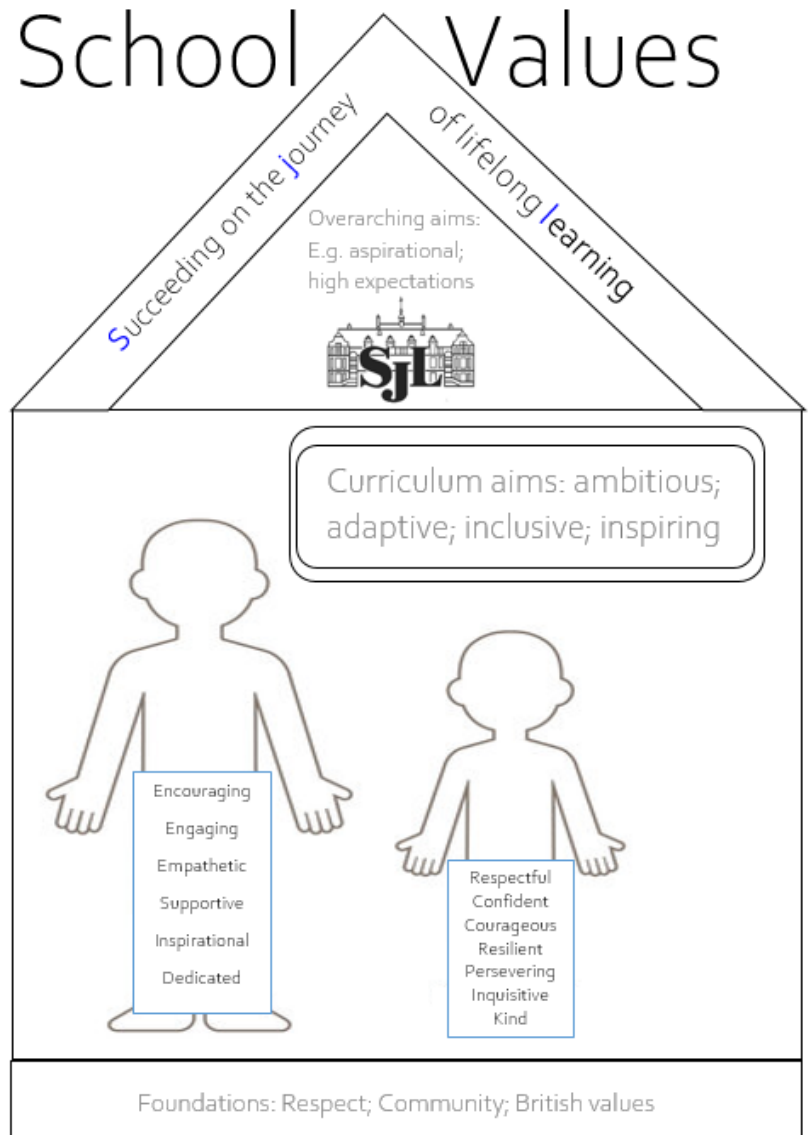
We have been reviewing our school values and vision.

We looked up how to plant the seeds to grow tulips next spring.



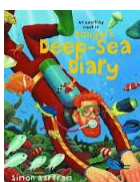
Look what Year 2 discovered in our library!

They are very happy to tell you about Dougal's adventures if you ask them.

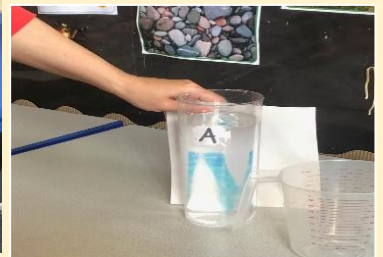
Have you read any books written by Simon Bartram?

We learned that the violin is held under the chin and has four strings. The strings are very tight and make a sound when the bow is pulled across them.

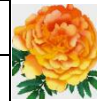
We know a lot about the piano because Scott plays ours. It was lovely to hear another pianist play to accompany his fellow musicians.



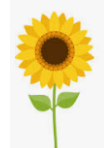
There was a snare drum, a bass drum, cymbals and hand drums. We learned how the drums came from the military and could be on straps and played or, as they were in assembly, on stands.

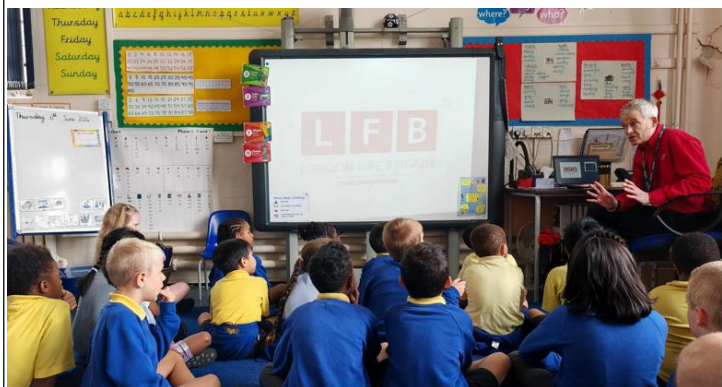
