Children will have lunch back at school.



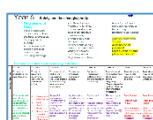
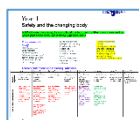

Safety is everyone's responsibility

Every few weeks, members of our CLT (Children's Leadership Team) join Juna on a Health and Safety walk.

On the most recent walk, the team walked the top floor noting down any concerns with cables, furniture, carpets, floor tiles, door handles, bookshelves, sinks, cupboard doors etc.

It was explained to the CLT members that some of the repairs could be done by Juna and some repairs would have to be done by specialist contractors such as plumbers, electricians or builders.

Juna has tightened screws on loose cupboard doors and the wobbly shelf in the art room. He has tidied the cables in the PPA room so that they are not a trip hazard and he has contacted the builders to look at where the paint on the wall is peeling and the carpet which is coming up in the corner of the learning pod.
