Remember we may be a few minutes late returning from the theatre at the end of the school day.

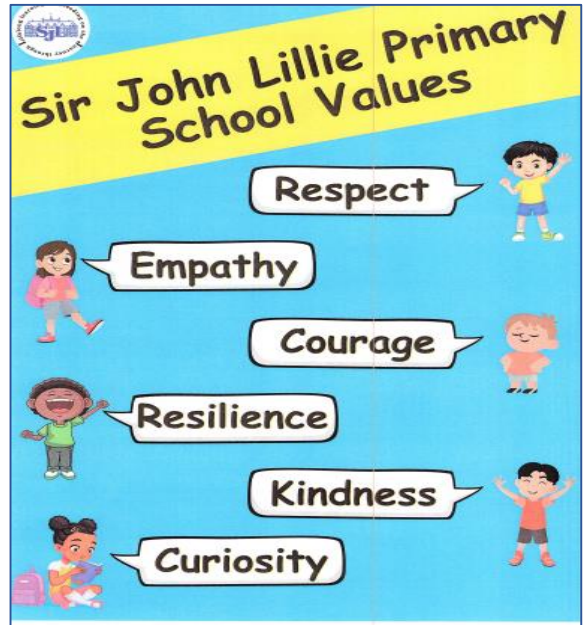

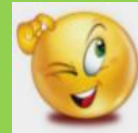
